**Liquid-cooled engine**

Developed from our winning race bikes, the DT's liquid-cooled 2-stroke engine is equipped with advanced technology including our torque-boosting Yamaha Power Valve System (YPVS).

**Long travel forks/  
Lightweight disc brake**

With its rugged long travel front forks the DT125R is ready to take on just about any terrain from city streets to bumpy trails - and for strong, reliable stopping power there's a lightweight front disc brake fitted with a tough plastic protector.

**Monocross rear suspension/Sturdy swinging arm**

Just like our winning YZ motocrossers the DT125R is equipped with Yamaha's long-travel Monocross rear suspension system for a comfortable ride, while the stiff box-section swinging arm ensures smooth handling.

**High rigidity frame**

Another direct spin-off from Yamaha's YZ motocross machinery is the DT125R's frame. Constructed from high-tensile steel tubing, this extremely strong semi-double cradle design resists flex to ensure agile handling and lightweight manoeuvrability on the street and in the dirt.

**Compact rear disc/Lightweight wheel/  
Dual purpose tyre**

Running with a special enduro-type dual purpose tyre designed for high traction on and off road, the lightweight spoked rear wheel is fitted with a compact rear disc for efficient braking in a variety of conditions.

**Motocross type air scoops/  
tank/radiator/seat**

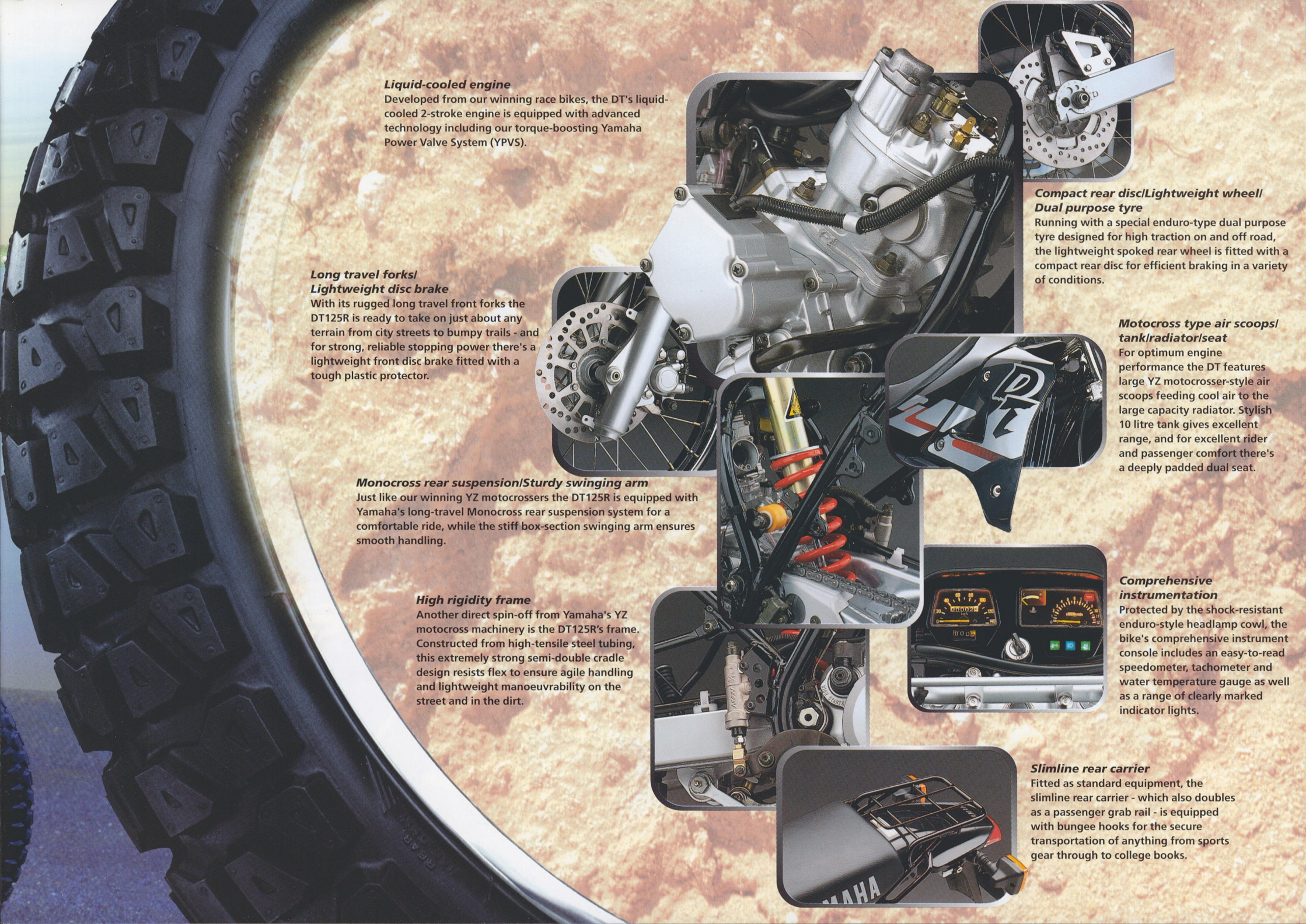

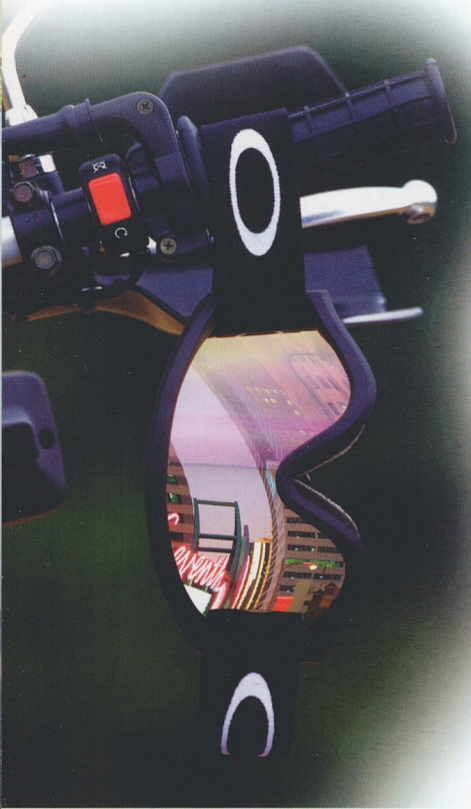
**Comprehensive instrumentation**
