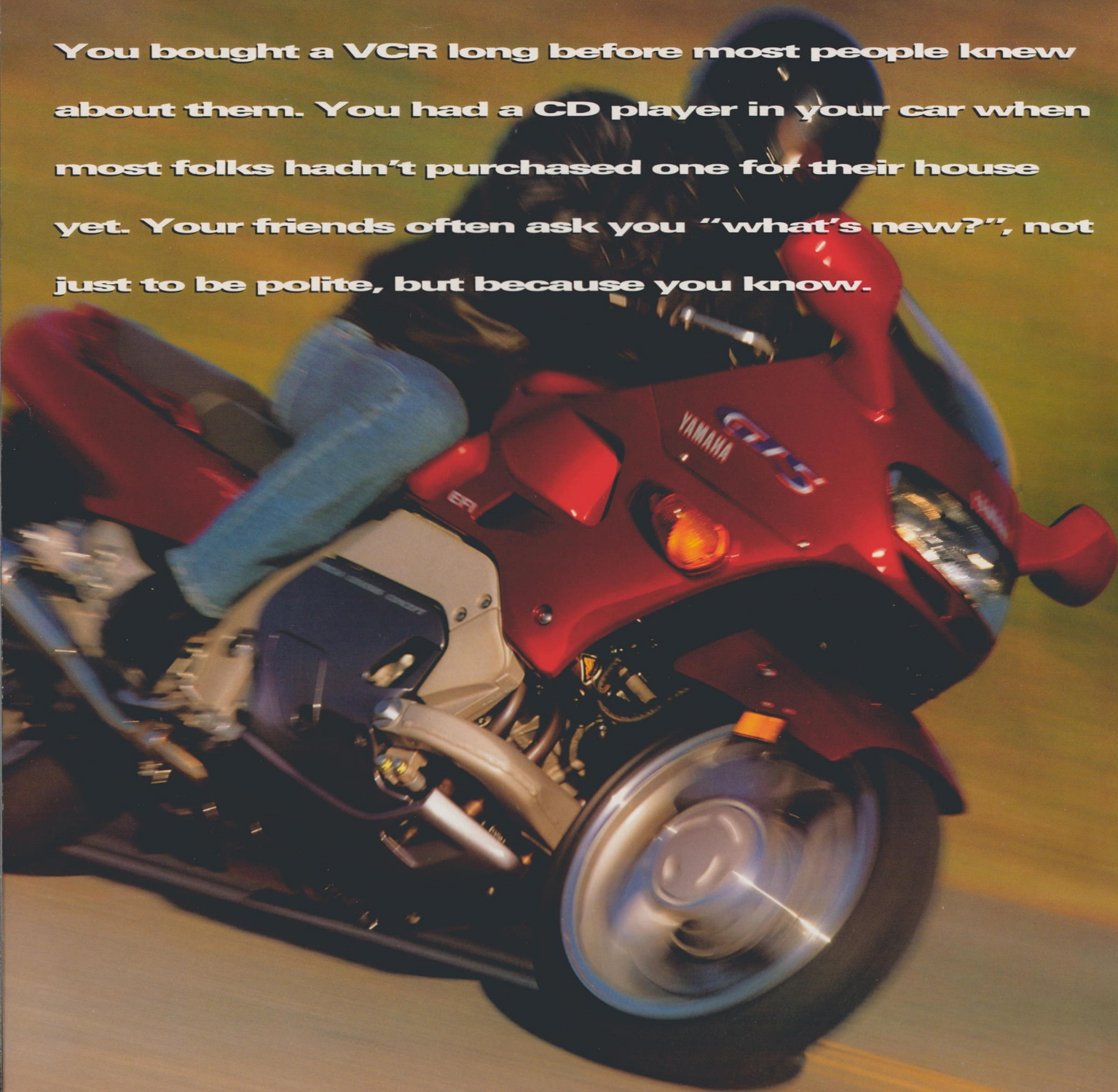


GTS1000A **YAMAHA**

The GTS1000A combines a wide variety of revolutionary engineering concepts to mark a new era in motorcycling—the civilized sport machine. ■ Powered by a 1003cc 5-valve engine, the GTS1000A is complete with fuel injection for immediate rider response. ■ This radically new machine opens the latest chapter in Genesis design, with the Omega chassis concept. This system lowers the center of gravity and adds rigidity to the frame. In addition it allowed engineers to install a single sided swingarm in front—rather than conventional forks. The results include outstanding handling, enhanced suspension performance and unparalleled rider comfort. ■ This new front suspension concept includes a fully adjustable single shock, with varying settings for preload, compression and rebound damping. The front details also include Anti-Lock Braking (as found on the rear), and a massive, 6 opposed piston caliper front disc brake. ■ To assist the fuel injected engine, there's a liquid cooled oil cooler and a large concave radiator with not one, but two fans to keep engine tem-

perature constant. ■ The full fairing design offers excellent wind protection and allows both the rider and passenger to sit in a comfortable position on the large, plush seat. There's even storage spaces in the tank and body for carrying small items. ■ As you'd expect, the GTS1000A has incredibly sophisticated instrumentation. There's an electronic tachometer and speedometer. Plus a sophisticated ignition system with an advanced anti-theft device. ■ Obviously the GTS1000A has performance. There's no doubting it's unique look and engineering marvels. It delivers exceptional handling. It's comfortable. And obviously, it's way ahead of it's time. ■
