



Fit this skid plate to prevent flying rocks from damaging your XT660R when you're headed into the rough stuff.

#### 3. Wind deflector

Heading off on a longer trip? Then you'll like this wind deflector which helps keep the wind blast off you at high speeds.

#### 4. Hand guards

Widely used in motocross and enduro racing, these hand guards protect your hands from rocks and stuff.

#### 5. Frame guards

If you plan on using your XT660R for some hard riding, these guards will help keep your bike pristine.
